

Get the support you need through The Glenn Crombie Centre for Student Support

To access disability-related services at Cambrian College, please bring:

- Your recent IPRC or Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- Any psycho-educational assessment
- Relevant medical reports

How do I get this information?

- The information will be available in your Ontario School Record (OSR), which you can request through the last high school you attended.
- These documents will be necessary in order to determine the level of support and services that you may require.
- Getting the paperwork in place is an important first step before accommodations can be provided. However, other services may be accessed through the Centre while you are waiting for your documentation.
- If you do not have documented disability, you may still qualify for our services. This interim support will be determined upon meeting with an Accessibility Advisor.

Make an appointment with an Accessibility Advisor at The Glenn Crombie Centre for Student Support

We recommend that you make an appointment with one of our Accessibility Advisors once you have decided to apply to Cambrian College.

- *Applying for OSAP?*
If you are eligible for OSAP, you also qualify for access to the Bursary for Students with Disabilities provided you have the appropriate supporting documentation.
- *Enrolling in our Orientation Program for students with learning or physical disabilities or mental health issues?*
This is a free, one-week orientation for students with disabilities. It provides information on services offered at Cambrian, assistive technology, and learning strategies.
