- the ability to maintain good working relationship with other members of the committee;
- Exhibit independence, objectivity, and a commitment to the AES;
- have organizational, problem solving and time management skills;
- be able to organize and present complex information clearly and accurately to the First Nations and seek their input on issues;
- have excellent written, oral and interpersonal communication skills;
- have computer skills, be able to navigate the Internet, use e-mail and Microsoft Office software;
- Demonstrate reliability, diplomacy, good judgment and confidentiality.
- Valid driver's licence.
