### ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

**Eligibility:** Applicant must be a registered full-time student at an accredited post-secondary college or university. Students who are currently enrolled as well as those who have completed studies and are graduating in 2018 are eligible.

Applicants must be a registered member of one of the 40 Anishinabek First Nations as represented by the Union of Ontario Indians.

**To Apply:** Eligible students are asked to submit:

- a short bio (tell us who you are, will also be used to introduce recipient);
- a letter outlining academic achievements, future aspirations, and community involvement;
- two (2) written academic references;
- an official transcript of your 2017/18 grades; and
- complete contact information including email address, complete mailing address and phone number
