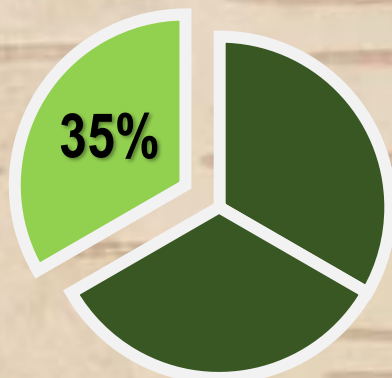


Wahnapiatae First Nation LAND CODE

April 18, 2024



WFN's Land Code will replace 44 sections (approx. 35%) of the Indian Act. All the other sections (ie. health, membership, tax exemption, etc.) will still apply.

WHAT IS...

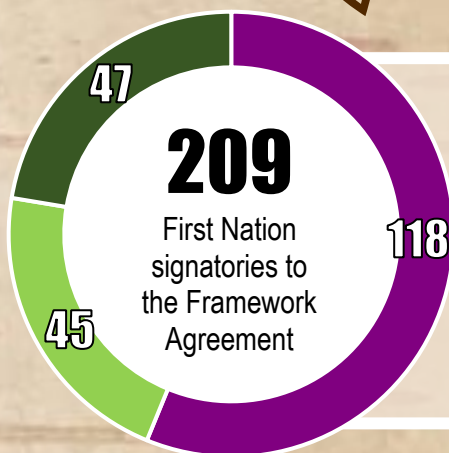
A LAND CODE?

Drafted by the Land Code Development Committee, it will be the basic enabling land law of Wahnapiatae First Nation which includes broad general principles that align with WFN's vision, priorities, culture, customs, and traditions.



AN INDIVIDUAL AGREEMENT?

Developed between Wahnapiatae and Canada, it is an agreement between the First Nation and Canada detailing the specifics of the transfer of reserve lands from Canada to Wahnapiatae First Nation's jurisdiction.



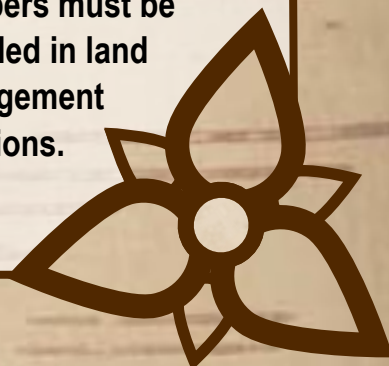
118 First Nations with ratified Land Codes
